Dear Attendees,

Welcome to **Mining & Critical Minerals Canada Conference and Exhibition!** We are honoured that you can join us here at this premier international event dedicated to critical minerals, mining and commodities here in Toronto, ON, Canada.

Canada has been in the global media spotlight for its efforts to boost its mining industry and secure critical minerals. Through its G7 Presidency, Canada has been working with international partners to strengthen supply chains, reduce dependencies and ensure access to the resources essential for clean energy, advanced manufacturing and defence.

In October, Canada's Minister of Energy and Natural Resources Tim Hodgson announced 26 new investments, partnerships and measures to accelerate and unlock \$6.4 billion of critical minerals projects. These measures include mobilizing public and private capital to accelerate critical mineral projects as well as stockpiling critical minerals as a national security priority. On the diplomatic front, Canada has also been formalising partnerships on critical minerals. The latest bilateral agreement was signed with Australia in November where both countries agreed to strengthen co-operation and trade on critical minerals.

Here in Ontario, in October, new rules have been introduced to cut mine approval times by half – a move that Energy and Mines Minister Stephen Lecce insisted will make the province more competitive in the global race to extract critical minerals. Dubbed "One Project, One Process" (1P1P), the framework creates a centralized permitting and authorization model that aims to approve advanced exploration and mine development projects in a maximum of two years. This reform aims to give investors and developers the confidence to build mines and create jobs across the province. With all these reforms and investments at a Federal and State level, we are optimistic about the future of critical minerals in Canada.

This event in Toronto is part of our global Energy Transition, Critical Minerals and Mining Investment Conference Series. To date, this Conference Series have been held in Singapore, Japan, India, Australia, UK, United Arab Emirates, Canada and USA. We also organise MiningTech Conferences in Vancouver, Canada and Sao Paulo, Brazil. Globally, our events cover Africa, Australia, Asia, Latin and North America and Europe. 
